Extension of rear basement and rear ground floor and erection of two rear dormers (retrospective) Coachmans Cottage, New Road High Birstwith – Reason for refusal – The 2 dormer windows, due to their size, design and position dominate the roof slope of the central section of the dwelling in a manner that detracts from the simple roof forms of the dwelling and appear visually prominent and intrusive, detrimental to the character of the ANOB is it contrary to Harrogate District Plan and the Council's Guidelines
