He suggested obtaining a 'Battle Box' which included first aid kit, high visibility jackets, torch and numerous other items to be placed somewhere in the village where it would be available 24/7. He also asked if we had any 1st responders in case of emergencies. The booklet he is compiling called 'Resilience Guide' requires considerable input from the PC and Cllr David Britton agreed to undertake this task

Play Area The new bank account is now open at Yorkshire Bank. Erosion of entrance pathway to Play Area due to excessive flood water over Christmas period. Contact to be made with NY Hghways apparently they diverted the water to this area. Insurance Co say path not covered. Two estimates received for repairs held in abeyance for the time being.

Highway matters: The Chairman reported he had contacted NY Highways regarding Hirst Lane, Hampsthwaite Lane and other areas causing concern

Birstwith Church FC – Lackon Bank footpath – HBC Community Initiative Fund have awarded $\pounds 400$ in support of this project. The Parish Council unanimously agreed to match this figure of $\pounds 400$ proposed by C Packer seconded by R Houseman

BHS 'Birstwith in Bloom' – letter received asking if a P Councillor would join their committee and C Packer agreed to undertake this task

NALC Transparency Fund for Smaller Authorities - The Chairman and Clerk had submitted the necessary paper work required in order to apply for funding to cover the costs of internet access and computer equipment
