Our Insurance Company have now had a change of heart and have agreed for us to make a claim. ~The clerk will forward the necessary info and estimates to them for approval and hopefully the work will be carried out shortly. Molehills are becoming a problem in the playground and it was proposed by M Worsnop seconded by D Britton that a mole repellant should be purchased. The Chairman will also talk to the mill manager regarding this problem and the state of the show field boundary gate and wall. J Elvidge was thanked for cutting the playground area but now only had the facility to use a strimmer. The Chairman agreed to ask Skeltons if they would include this area along with our other contract
