7 UPDATES REGARDING:

Play Area - It was proposed by D Britton seconded by R Houseman that a Hydraulic Damper be purchased for the outside gate of the playground. Mark Hanslow has kindly agreed to fit it for us. The cost will be £84.65 the PC will pay this a/c and reclaim the money from the Playground a/c. John Elvidge will check the fixings on the swings as soon as the weather improves.

Highway Matters – Hampsthwaite Lane still no reply from Highways Engineer. Damage to School barrier – Chair of School Governors chased repairs the sand bags have been replaced and the work should be completed shortly. Goyt on Wreaks Road temporary filling has come out and blocked drains. The Gully outside The Moss on Wreaks Road has still not been cleaned out. The pot hole on Station Road has been reported to Highways it is difficult to miss when overtaking the parked cars at the end of Collin Bank. Parish Council workshops to be organised by Area 6 Boroughbridge Area Office the Chairman expressed an interest in attending.

Grass Cutting – The Chairman and Cllr Houseman will meet up shortly to finalise the area of verges etc to enable us to get quotations. Cllr Britton and Houseman were thanked for their work in obtaining appropriate plans to work from.

Birstwith in Bloom – An inventory had been received along with their new Constitution but not a copy of their current public liability insurance. The clerk to request this for the PC records. The compost heap at the back of Broomfield has had verbal agreement from HBC but BIB are awaiting written confirmation.

Grit Bins for Birstwith Grange and The Allotments - R Houseman proposed seconded by M Worsnop that a grit bin be purchased for Birstwith Grange. The cost at present would be £50 per bin but although agreed left in abeyance until the Autumn. The Allotments is a private road and therefore the PC would not be able to fund this one.
